She relished the continuous challenge of finding a solution – often to problems that had never before been tackled.

"We often work in the *boundary areas*, where public health, environmental engineering, industrial hygiene and public relations intersect," explains Dr. Conibear. "We can be effective here

because we have a team with strong expertise in the applied sciences of industrial hygiene and environmental engineering, architecture, statistics, geology, occupational safety and occupational medicine. We take a multidisciplinary approach to problem solving on a wide array of projects, particularly projects without precedent, from conceptualization to conclusion."

In one example, CCA took on a project for a large suburban school system where others had tried and failed. The school system was dealing with a state-mandated shutdown of its facility; confronted with the possibility of demolishing a \$20M+ public asset; and faced with a community that was convinced that the school would never be made suitable for its children or teachers. In nine months, Dr. Conibear and the CCA team not only restored the building's air quality but also restored the confidence of the parents and state and local school officials that the building was once again safe for children, teachers and staff.
